**Ans.4(A)** "Is" is a form of the verb to be, which indicates a state of existence or functions as an auxiliary verb. Is is the third-person singular present tense of to be. "Are" is also a conjugated form of to be. Are is the first-person plural present, second-person singular and plural present, and third-person plural present tense of this verb.

**Ans.5(A)** We use between to refer to two things which are clearly separated. We use among to talk about things which are not clearly separated because they are part of a group or crowd or mass of objects.
