## 1. Introduction to Canva

Canva is a user-friendly graphic design tool perfect for creating social media graphics, presentations, posters, documents, and more. It offers a drag-and-drop interface and a vast library of templates and design elements.

Key Features:

- Web-based platform (no installation required)
- Free and Pro versions
- Thousands of customizable templates
- Easy sharing and download options

## 2. Getting Started with Canva

Steps:

1. Visit [www.canva.com](https://www.canva.com)
2. Sign up using email or Google account
3. Choose your purpose (personal, business, education, etc.)
4. Explore the dashboard:

- R: Insert rectangle
- T: Insert text box
- L: Insert line
- Group/Ungroup elements for easier editing

- Download formats: PNG, JPG, PDF, MP4, GIF
- Share via link or email directly from Canva
- Collaborate with team members
